I chose to work under Dr. Susan Raatz at the University of Minnesota. My research project titled "Eating Patterns Study" was a pilot project investigating the relationship between diet choices and obesity. Participants were placed in either a fast-food group vs. a home meal group and were educated on healthy dietary choices and decisions they could make at both locations. This population was followed and participants were measured for changes in weight and health status on a bi-weekly basis.
